FOR USE OUTDOORS

STEP 1: MAKE YOUR SNOBALLS

- Pour 1 x 20g bag of SnoBall powder into a suitable bowl or container. Please note: SnoBall powder expands a lot, so use a bowl that can hold at least 2 Litres of water.
- 2. Pour approximately 1.2 litres of water onto the SnoBall powder and mix thoroughly with your hand. Hot or cold water can be used, but colder water will feel more realistic! **DO NOT USE BOILING WATER.**
- **3.** Start making your SnoBalls. If your snow isn't sticking together properly, try adding some more water and try again.

Top tip: For best results the size of your SnoBalls should be in-between a Golf ball and a Tennis ball.

STEP 2: DISPOSE OF YOUR SNOBALLS

Please note: This should be done by an adult.

- 1. Sweep or collect up as much of the SnoBalls as you can. Ensure snow is rinsed off painted and wooden surfaces after use. Do not leave in large clumps on grass.
- 2. Sno can then be disposed of in your general waste, or you can pour it down the toilet and flush.

Alternatively, Sno can be disposed of by mixing it in with soil in your garden, and will actually help plants and flowers retain water!

Please note: Sno should NOT be disposed of down your sink.

FOR USE INDOORS

STEP 1: MAKE YOUR SNO

- 1. Pour 1 x 20g bag of SnoBall powder into a suitable bowl or container.

 Please note: SnoBall powder expands a lot, so use a bowl that can hold at least 1 Litre of water.
- 2. Pour approximately 500ml of water (for fluffy snow) onto the SnoBall powder and mix thoroughly with your hand. Hot or cold water can be used, but colder water will feel more realistic! **DO NOT USE BOILING WATER.**Please note: The more water you add, the stickier and mushier the Sno will get. So if you want to make more mouldable Sno, simply add more water!
- 3. Your sno is now ready to use!

Why not add some arctic animal figures to create an snowy arctic sensory tub?!

STEP 2: DISPOSE OF YOUR SNO

Please note: This should be done by an adult.

- 1. When you're finished, gather your Sno together in a large bowl or bucket, and add more water to dilute the Sno into a drainable liquid.
- 2. The Sno will be thinner and can easily be drained away. Carefully pour your Gelli down the toilet and flush.
